CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Judging will be in accordance with National Rose Society of Australia Inc. Standards & Rules for Judging Roses (Version 3, 2024). Total Point Allocation for judging is 100 points – refer table over page.
2. Entry is open to all Queensland Rose Society Members.
3. All blooms exhibited must be grown by the exhibitor.
4. Exhibits must be tabled by 7.25pm.

DEFINITIONS

Bud: A bud is the unexpanded stage of a rose flower with no petals unfurling.

Cultivar: means **one-cultivated variety** – e.g. the 'Peace' Rose.

Decorative Hybrid Tea Rose: This is a rose which displays petals of good substance which are gracefully arranged in its most decorative phase. Form is not a criterium although symmetry is important. It should be displayed with foliage and, side buds are permitted. Any Hybrid Tea Rose may be entered as a Decorative Hybrid Tea rose, however, roses in this category are not judged on form or size. SEE TABLE OVER PAGE.

Exhibition Hybrid Tea Rose: This is a single bloom rose that has a high-pointed centre with good form, size, substance, brilliance and purity of colour. When viewed from above the outer petals of the bloom should display a circular outline. It must be staged with its own stem and foliage with no side buds. SEE TABLE OVER PAGE.

Multi-Stage Exhibition: 3 stems of one cultivar of rose in 3 stages of opening, bud must show colour with no petals unfurling and fully open stage must be full bloom.

NND: means Not Necessarily Distinct – i.e. 3 of the same cultivar or 2 the same plus a different cultivar or 3 different cultivars.

Stem and Cut: A **Stem** is defined as an original new growth which carries 1 bloom or 1 bud and has received no check from pinching, stopping or pruning from the time of starting into growth to flowering. Disbudding is not regarded as a check to growth under this definition. The stem should be proportionate in thickness and length to the size of the bloom it supports. A **Cut** is similar to a stem: an original new growth that carries 1 bloom and bud or buds, or more than 1 bloom with or without side buds.

PRIZES

Best Exhibit Section 1 (classes 1-4), Section 2 (classes 5-8), Sections 3,4 & 5 (classes 9-11), Sections 6 & 7 (classes 12-18) at the Judge's discretion.

Best Novice Exhibit Section 8, (classes 19-23) at the Judge's discretion.

Best Exhibit of the Show.

Placings may not be awarded in every class.

Prizes may be a choice of product donated by sponsors.

Points will be allocated to placings and will go towards aggregated annual awards.
